

Larry Dill Biography

Rev. Dr. Larry Dill has been Executive Director of the Institute for Clergy Excellence since February 1, 2003. He and his wife, Peggy, are the parents of two sons, Randy, an Assistant District Attorney, in Madison County, Alabama; and David, an Episcopal Priest, and grand parents of Ella and Lena.
